SunRail can take you to Orlando International Airport. Simply take SunRail to the Sand Lake Road station and transfer for free onto LYNX's LINK 111.

Show your same-day ticket or SunCard, and LYNX will deliver you directly to Terminal A in approximately 15 minutes.

All SunRail trains are timed to meet up with the 111. For the return, simply pay LYNX \$2 and ask for a transfer ticket to SunRail.
