NEW SCHEDULE



New Service Schedule Announced

SunRail has announced service changes that go into effect on Monday, July 23 for our Phase 1 stations. The new schedule includes expanded service hours, four additional trains and mid-day gap closures that are expected to better serve our commuters and leisure travelers.

"We've listened to our customers. Our goal was to provide service that enhanced our current operation by providing more opportunity for our current riders to use the train and create opportunity for new riders to become SunRail commuters," said SunRail CEO, Nicola Liquori. "Our operations team and business development team worked closely together to create the best possible schedule within the confines of our operational agreements. We believe these changes will provide more Central Floridians the opportunity to utilize SunRail for multiple shift-times at employers such as the hospitals and OIA while allowing others to use the train for mid-day meetings and lunch outings along the corridor."

Two surveys conducted in May of employees at both Florida Hospital and Orlando Health were used to help craft times to better meet the needs of these large employee populations and their multiple shift workers. Multiple meetings and outreach with Orlando International Airport employers also played a role in crafting the new schedule.

Leisure travelers benefit too, as the new schedule will allow riders to ride SunRail later in the evenings and more often throughout the afternoons, which is great news for retail, dining and entertainment venues along the corridor.

Connectivity times have been coordinated with partners LYNX, Votran and the Sanford CRA, sponsors of a free trolley service from the Sanford station to Historic Downtown Sanford.

Fares

Reloadable SunCards

SunCards have a one-time cost of \$5 and can carry a pass as well as hold a prepaid value.

Pass – A pass gives you the freedom to ride on SunRail as many times as you want for 7, 30 or 365 consecutive calendar days after you first Tap On and provides significant savings over one-way or round-trip tickets.

Prepaid Value – Similar to a debit card, your fare is deducted based on the distance traveled on your trip, and funds can be added to your card as often as needed. Passengers who use prepaid value automatically receive a 10% bonus when funds are loaded onto their SunCard.

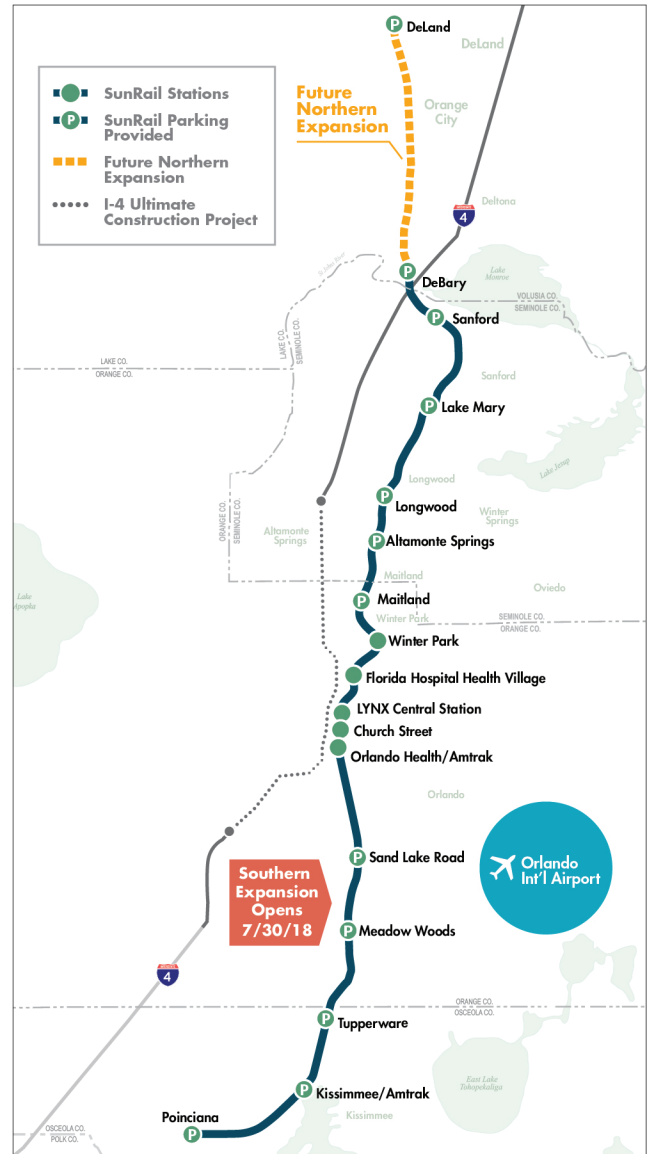
Discounts
