In late January, 2015, I-4 begins a 6-year, 21-mile reconstruction project between SR 434 in Longwood and Kirkman Road.

SunRail Alternative

SunRail is Central Florida's commuter rail line providing a convenient and enjoyable travel option for residents and visitors alike. The line currently features 12 convenient stations:

- DeBary
- Sanford
- Lake Mary
- Longwood
- Altamonte Springs
- Maitland
- Winter Park
- Florida Hospital Health Village
- LYNX Central Station
- Church Street
- Orlando Health/Amtrak
- Sand Lake Road

Phase 2 extensions, expected to open in 2017, will include five additional stations, extending service north to DeLand and south to Poinciana.



How To Ride

SunRail features a Tap On/Tap Off technology to monitor rider ticket purchases. When you arrive at the station, Tap On by simply scanning your ticket or SunCard at one of three ticket validators located on each platform. Upon arriving at your destination station, Tap Off at a ticket validator. This will ensure you are charged the proper fare amount.



To Pay Fare:

- 1 TAP ON
to board train
- 2 TAP OFF
at destination

Train Tracker

Track your train in real-time on the homepage of SunRail.com.

Trip Planner

SunRail's Trip Planner on SunRail.com provides transportation options to your desired destination using SunRail and other means of public transportation.

Bus Transfers

From SunRail to the Bus: Pay the train fare, then show the LYNX/Votran operator your SunCard or ticket and receive a free transfer to a feeder bus route.

From the Bus to SunRail: Pay the bus fare on a LYNX/Votran feeder bus route and ask the operator for a free one-county SunRail transfer. Take the transfer to a SunRail ticket vending machine located on the SunRail platform and swipe to receive a SunRail ticket. Transfers are valid for 90 minutes. Pay a \$1 upgrade for crossing each county line on SunRail, if necessary.

Fares

Single-Day Tickets

One-way and round-trip tickets are valid for travel on day of purchase only.

Riders over age 65, between the ages of 7-17 and those with disabilities as certified by LYNX or Votran, can purchase Single-Day tickets and Travel Plans for 50% off. Children age 6 and under ride for free with a paying adult (limit 3).

Reloadable SunCards

SunCards have a one-time cost of \$5 and can carry one Travel Plan as well as hold a Prepaid Value.

Travel Plans – Travel Plans give you the freedom to ride on SunRail as many times as you want for 7, 30 or 365 consecutive calendar days after you first Tap On. These plans provide significant savings over a Single-Day ticket.

Prepaid Value – Similar to a debit card, your fare is deducted based on the distance traveled on your trip, and funds can be added to your card as often as needed. Passengers who purchase a SunCard with Prepaid Value also receive a 10% bonus when funds are loaded onto the card. Additional discounts for seniors, youth or the disabled do not apply.
