HOW TO RIDE

- Purchase your ticket or SunCard
- Tap On your ticket or SunCard on the ticket validator
- Board Train
- At destination, Tap Off at the ticket validator



To Pay Fare:

- 1 TAP ON to board train
- 2 TAP OFF at destination

FARES

Tickets

One-way and round-trip tickets are valid for travel on day of purchase only and are nonrefundable.

Reloadable SunCards

SunCards have a one-time cost of \$5 and can carry a pass as well as hold a prepaid value.

Pass – A pass gives you the freedom to ride on SunRail as many times as you want for 7, 30 or 365 consecutive calendar days after you first Tap On and provides significant savings over one-way and round-trip tickets.

Prepaid Value – Similar to a debit card, your fare is deducted based on the distance traveled on your trip, and funds can be added to your card as often as needed. Passengers who use prepaid value automatically receive a 10% bonus when funds are loaded onto a SunCard.

Discounts

Riders 65 and over, youth between the ages of 7-18 and those with disabilities as certified by LYNX or Votran receive 50% off their fare. Children age 6 and under ride for free with a paying adult (limit 3).
