Buy One, Give One Rides One Day Only
November 29, 2024**

ORLANDO, Fla. – SunRail is offering a special Buy One, Give One “BOGO” promotion on Friday, November 29, 2024. For one day only, SunRail customers can buy a ride and their friend or family member rides free! Riders can take SunRail on Black Friday to support local businesses, restaurants, and venues.

- A one-way or round-trip ticket may be purchased on the Mobile Ticket App or at any Ticket Vending Machine for one rider, and their friend/family member will ride free.
- Current SunCard holders will need to tap on before riding to serve as their paid fare for their companion to ride free.
- Additional riders must accompany friends/family members with a ticket or SunCard to be eligible to ride for free. “Free” fare must be redeemed on Friday, November 29 and cannot be saved or used for future travel dates.
